Day 1: Board your coach and spend the day getting acquainted with fellow traveling companions, your Tour Director and Driver. Your destination for the night is the **Best Western Kokopelli Lodge** in Clayton, New Mexico.

Day 2: This morning visit the **Trinidad, Colorado History Museum**. The museum occupies an entire city block with four buildings and gardens. Your visit includes guided tours of the Baca House & Bloom Mansion (if available), and self-guided tours of the Santa Fe Trail

Museum & Baca-Bloom Heritage Gardens, at your own pace. Need to rest...there is seating in the Trail Museum & Gardens, a Museum bookstore & restrooms. After lunch in Trinidad, continue to your accommodations in **Cortez, CO** at the **Holiday Inn Express**. (B)

Day 3: It's only a short drive to **Mesa Verde National Park** which is one of the nation's major archaeological preserves. Here one can see some of the world's largest & best preserved cliff dwellings in this 52,000-acre park. Visit the **Chapin Mesa Archeological Museum & see Spruce Tree House**, the 3rd largest cliff dwelling & the best preserved. A **knowledgeable & entertaining guide** boards your coach for a **narrated driving** tour of the park. After lunch at Mesa Verde, continue to **Four Corners**, the only place in the United States where four states - Colorado, Arizona, Utah and New Mexico - have a common meeting point. Continue on to **Kayenta, Arizona** for your next overnight at the **Kayenta Monument Valley Inn**. (CB)

Day 4: This morning take a short drive to **Goulding's Trading Post** in Monument Valley to board a special touring bus for a **narrated tour by a Navajo guide** into **Monument Valley**. Immense mesas, buttes, spires and dome rock formations of reds, oranges and yellows shine brightly against a brilliant blue skyline. A million and a half years of weathering have worn away huge amounts of soft rock, leaving these monoliths with their erosion-resistant caps of DeChelly sandstone. **Lunch included**



upon your return at **Goulding's Trading Post**. Stop along the route at roadside stands where Native Americans sell jewelry, pottery and samples of Navajo fry bread. The **Page/Lake Powell area** is your destination for the night. Accommodations are at the **Courtyard by Marriott Page, AZ**. (B, L)

Day 5: This morning enjoy **Lake Powell's Canyons Adventure Boat Cruise** that includes an excursion through the **twisting Antelope Canyons** and a great view of the Glen Canyon Dam. But the highlight is **Navajo Canyon** and its beautiful **Navajo Tapestry laden walls**. Navajo legend tells us that the colors were formed by the blood of a monster killed in this region. After lunch in Page depart for Utah with accommodations at the new **Best Western Bryce Canyon Grand Hotel, East Bryce, Utah**. (B)

Day 6: Thousands of delicately carved spires rise in brilliant color from the amphitheaters of **Bryce Canyon National Park**. Millions of years of wind, water and geologic mayhem have shaped and etched the pink cliffs at Bryce, which isn't actually a canyon but the eastern slope of the Paunsaugunt Plateau. With a **park guide** see some of the world's best scenery, including weird-looking formations known as hoodoos. Next visit **Zion National Park**, a land of sheer cliffs, ancient sand dunes, amazing vistas and verdant garden alcoves. Visitors gaze in awe at the majesty of Zion's grandeur with pedestals of stone so tall and massive they seem to support the sky. Take a **narrated Tram Tour** and be prepared as you will soon understand exactly the grandeur that overcame Mormon

Isaac Behunin when he named this place, ZION! Overnight at one of your favorite places, **Majestic View Lodge**, a serene location. Enjoy! (CB, L)

Day 7: Destination today is **Moab, UT** for an opportunity to tour two outstanding National Parks. Enjoy **Arches National Park with a step-on guide** for a fully narrated tour. Highlights include entertaining & educational information with views of Balanced Rock, the Windows area and Delicate Arch. Check into the **Holiday Inn Express**, your accommodations for the night. Finally the finishing touch for a perfect day provided by **Canyonlands by Night & Day** starts with a **Dutch Oven Buffet Dinner** served right on the scenic Colorado River. Then board a slow moving boat for a scenic ride...this is by far one of the most unique sound & light shows in the world and has been hailed by many as "the highlight of their vacation" enjoy!!! (B, D)

Day 8: Continue on across Colorado, into Kansas where overnight accommodations await at the **Hampton Inn Colby, Kansas**. (CB)

Day 9: Plenty of time to reminisce as you travel back to Oklahoma with unforgettable memories and tons of photos of scenery so magnificent that one can't possibly capture it all on film. (CB)

How To Come Along on Travel Tours Trips-Send full name, address and **\$50.00** per person (unless individual tour specified) deposit to Travel Tours, Box 40, Wagoner, OK 74477-0040. **Balance is due no later than six (6) weeks prior to departure** (Statements will not be mailed out). Please identify the tour number.

Cancellation and Refund Policy - All cancellations MUST be made during normal business hours. Unless specified otherwise, *cancellations made more than 31 days prior to departure* will be entitled to a full refund, less any special event tickets that had to be pre-purchased. For *cancellation made less than 31 days but more than 48 hours prior to departure*, there will be a 10% cancellation fee plus any non-refundable expenses incurred by Travel Tours for hotels, attractions, transportation or other supplies related to the tour. *No refunds will be issued for cancellation madewithin 48 hours of departure*. If you are

forced to leave a tour after departure, no refunds will be given for unused portions. To safeguard against unforeseen circumstances we suggest travelers obtain travel insurance.
