Day 1: Relive the early days of the West on this special tour to the awe-inspiring **Mount Rushmore** with accommodations at one of your favorite places, the **K Bar S Lodge in Keystone** for three wonderful nights. Tonight accommodations are in **York, Nebraska at the Hampton Inn. (L)**

Day 2: This morning travel across Nebraska into South Dakota. Early evening arrive in **Keystone and the K Bar S Lodge** located on 31 tree-covered acres with breathtaking views. Get acquainted with the Lodge before an **included Wine Reception & buffet dinner. (CB, D)**

Day 3: A local guide boards your coach as you head for **Badlands National Park** consisting of 244,000 acres of sharply eroded buttes, pinnacles and spires blended with the largest protected mixed grass prairie in the United States. It is desolation at its truest where you can look for miles and see no sign of civilization. The Badlands also preserve the world's largest fossil beds of animals from the Oligocene Epoch of the Age of



Mammals. Wildlife roams the park's boundaries as well. You'll also stop at **Wall Drug**, the world's most famous drugstore! Finish your day with the **Flying T Chuckwagon Supper & Show. (CB, D)**

Day 4: All Aboard! the 1880s Train and immerse yourself in the staggering beauty of the Black Hills, gliding over the rugged landscape aboard a vintage train like those that helped settle the Great American West. Ride from Keystone one way to Hill City. Enjoy a little shopping in Hill City and lunch on your own. Few truly wild places remain wild in this country. **Custer State Park** is one of them. The park is home to a variety of wildlife and magnificent scenery spanning 71,000 acres and is the second largest state park in the U.S. Nearly 1500 bison roam the prairies and hills, which they share with pronghorn, elk, goats and burros. See some of these magnificent animals on a **Buffalo Jeep Safari tour** into the park's back country. Return to the K Bar S Lodge for rest and relaxation. Take in the majestic 60-foot faces of our U.S. Presidents gazing out over South Dakota's Black Hills at **Mount Rushmore**, ranked second only to the Golden Gate Bridge as one of the "Seven Manmade Wonders of the U.S.". Dinner on your own at the Mt. Rushmore Café, then take a seat for the **Lighting Ceremony** for an **Illuminated Mount Rushmore! (CB)**

Day 5: This morning visit the **Crazy Horse Memorial**, the world's largest sculpture to honor the Lakota Leader. Explore the museum and various galleries with thousands of rare artifacts and beautiful works of art at your leisure. This afternoon visit the historic outpost Fort Robinson State Park that served from the days of the Indian Wars until after WWII. This was the site of the 1879 Cheyenne Outbreak & the death of famed Sioux Chief Crazy Horse. Visit the museum and restored buildings and take a horse drawn tour around the park. Overnight at the new **Hampton Inn Sidney, NE. (CB)**

Day 6: Sit back & relax on this designed day of travel to the **Hampton Inn in Salina, KS** for the night. **(CB)**

Day 7: Experience treasures from around the world and through the ages at one of Wichita's top-rated attractions, the **Museum of World Treasures**....Egyptian mummies, dinosaurs, early frontier exhibits, military collection and much more! Arrive back home with lots of wonderful memories shared with fellow traveling companions. **(CB)**

GENERAL INFORMATION

How To Come Along on Travel Tours Trips-Send full name, address and **\$50.00** per person (unless individual tour specified) deposit to Travel Tours, Box 40, Wagoner, OK 74477-0040. **Balance is due no later than six (6) weeks prior to departure** (Statements will not be mailed out). Please identify the tour number.

Cancellation and Refund Policy - All cancellations MUST be made during normal business hours. Unless specified otherwise, cancellations made more than 31 days prior to departure will be entitled to a full refund, less any special event tickets that had to be pre-purchased. For cancellation made less than 31 days but more than 48 hours prior to departure, there will be a 10% cancellation fee plus any non-refundable expenses incurred by Travel Tours for hotels, attractions, transportation or other supplies related to the tour. No refunds will be issued for cancellation made within 48 hours of departure. If you are forced to leave a tour after departure, no refunds will be given for unused portions. To safeguard against unforeseen

circumstances we suggest travelers obtain travel insurance.

Early Booking Discount (EBD) - The EBD is a discount that is earned when you book on a tour and remit your deposit a minimum of 60 days in advance of the tour departure date. Most of our tours have an EBD and it is typically listed with the tour pricing.

Insurance - Travel Tours cannot assume liability for lost or damaged luggage. Baggage insurance is available through Travel Tours. Trip cancellation and accident insurance is recommended and may be obtained through the Travel Tours Office.

Membership - Tour membership is open to all persons ages 5 and up, however, we reserve the right to reject or terminate the membership of any person whom Travel Tours may consider objectionable to the tour. Applicants with a disability are welcome on our tours. If you have a disability and would like to request specific accommo-
